According to a survey, over 22% of the city's residents are classified as "food insecure"—the highest rate in the entire state of Pennsylvania. This lack of access in the region inspired Tatiana Garcia-Granados and her husband to found Common Market in 2008. The company provides schools, hospitals, universities, grocery stores and workplaces with fresh produce grown by the region's sustainable farmers.

Initially, Common Market was able to manage its operations using QuickBooks. However, as it grew, Common Market needed more scalable and automated tools. They began working with Philadelphia-based software provider and Progress partner, Integrated Management Solutions, to implement its Food Connex Cloud Food Management System. The cloud-based solution utilizes the [Progress OpenEdge](#) product to allow Common Market to work in real-time with high levels of transparency and traceability.
